Evening Prayer and Benediction. We'll end the evening with a glass of wine and cake etc to celebrate our newest saint and our joint patron.

Children from our **4 Cluster Schools** will be coming together for a special workshop on Thursday 10th October, to reflect on his life and to create 4 special displays. These will be blessed at a Mass at the end of the day and then placed in each church.

On Sunday 13th October we will have special Mass at 10am at **Holy Trinity, Bilston**, where we will watch the Canonisation in Rome and then make live contact with our 'roving reporter' who will be in Rome itself.
